For more than 30 years, we have supported health and education in Guatemala.

Since 2007 FUNCOLI has been working at the villages of Vuelta Grande located in the mountains surrounding Antigua Guatemala.

This community consists of approximately 400 families, an estimated of 1200 adults and 1000 children encouraged by Free Hearts Foundation to get educated.

Teachers of FUNCOLI visited periodically the families of the community to convince them of the importance of sending their children to school.

Anually Funcoli registered an average of 150 children from 4 to 12 years oldto start studying that have never attedend school before.

At FUNCOLI we give specialized courses for adults to increase job opportunities for greater economic development for all the community. So far interest has been shown for the following courses:









Ecological Stoves

Ecological Stoves help mainly to reduce skin infection and respiratory diseases due to less inhalation of smoke. These ecological stoves use 70% less combustible materials, they also contribute to conserve the local forests.



Donation of ecological stoves

On March 14, 2022 we received a donation of 20 ecological stoves from Columbus State University from USA. Training was carried out for the benefited families, teaching them the benefits, maintenance and how to install them in their own homes.



A total of 148 stoves were already donated in the past years to the community. There are still many households in the surrounding communities that still don't own an ecological stove.

Dry Latrines

The latrines greatly reduce contamination of ground water. This project is of extreme importance because of the lack of water in the community, we are still missing more than 100 latrines approximately.
